## FEDERAL LAW GIVES YOU THE RIGHT TO

- · Form, join, or assist a union;
- Choose representatives to bargain with us on your behalf;
- Act together with other employees for your benefit and protection;
- Choose not to engage in any of these protected activities.

**WE WILL NOT** arbitrarily reduce the seniority of union members who are entitled to retain their seniority under the collective-bargaining agreement.

**WE WILL NOT** in any like or related manner interfere with, restrain, or coerce members in the exercise of the rights guaranteed them by Section 7 of the Act.

**WE WILL** make Stevenson Polintan whole for any loss of earnings and other benefits resulting from our unlawful reduction of his seniority, plus interest, and **WE WILL** also make him whole for any other direct or foreseeable pecuniary harms suffered as a result of the unlawful reduction of his seniority, plus interest.

**WE WILL** compensate Stevenson Polintan for the adverse tax consequences, if any, of receiving a lump-sum backpay award, and **WE WILL** file with the Regional Director for Region 19, within 21 days of the date the amount of backpay is fixed, either by agreement or Board order, a report allocating the backpay award to the appropriate calendar years.
